Performing minor repairs and troubleshooting, adjustments and treating structures such as showers, floors, sinks, walls, carpets and doors, servicing kitchen appliances and emergency equipment reporting mechanical malfunctions for action exercising discretion to identify projects that need higher skilled crafts and/or individual services. Assists in performing scheduled and "as needed" inspection and preventative maintenance on tools and equipment to maintain operability of the tools and equipment.

- Basic knowledge of safety codes and home repairs, i.e. plumbing, painting, electricity, and carpentry.
- Ability to engage and communicate effectively with support staff members, supervisors, and administrators.
- Favorable background check.
- Maintain driver's license with a 'clear' driving motor vehicle record in accordance with established guidelines of the corporation, access to reliable and safe transportation for self.
- Knowledge of vehicle safety.
- Capable of standing and working on your feet for long periods.
- Capable of bending and stooping repeatedly during the day.
- Bilingual preferred.
- Ability to lift at least 50 pounds without strain.
- Willingness and ability to work effectively with co-workers (teamwork)
- Effective time management skills required; ability to organize work.
- Required at times to be on call during off duty hours.
